



Registration Tip Sheet

What you need to know before registering for Courage

- 1. If you have participated in this event in the past, you will be required to register with your same username and password as in previous years.**
 - a. If you do not remember your username and/or password, you can click on “login” on the top right corner of the Courage homepage, and a box will appear where you can select “forgot username or password.”
- 2. Will you be signing up individually or will you be signing up as part of a team?**
 - a. If you are signing up individually, click on the “register as an individual” button.
 - b. If you are the Team Captain forming a team, click on the “form a team” button. Make sure your teammates know your team name so they can join, too!
 - c. If you are **not** a team captain, but you are joining a team, click on the “join a team” button. You will need to know the name of the team you wish to join so you can search for it, and that team will need to have already been created by your team captain.
 - d. If you are joining a team and you do not yet see your team there, sign up as an individual. Once your Team Captain registers your team, you will be able to join by logging into your participant center with your username and password.
- 3. Will you be riding or virtually riding?**
 - a. Rider Registration – Cle Elum to Leavenworth and back over Blewett and Old Blewett Passes (August 29 and 30)
 - Adult: \$75 registration fee, \$750 fundraising minimum
 - Youth: (Ages 13-17): \$50 registration fee, \$500 fundraising minimum
 - b. Virtual Rider – no riding necessary!
 - No registration fee, no fundraising minimum. You’ll be set up with a fundraising page so you can support Mary Bridge even if you can’t make it to the event.
- 4. Which cause do you want to support?**
 - a. Riders can choose between two causes to fundraise for. Visit the Cause page at ridewithcourage.org to learn more about each fund.
 - Child Abuse Intervention Department (CAID)
 - Where The Need Is Greatest
- 5. Who will your emergency contact be?**
 - a. You will need to input the name and phone number of the person who should be contacted in the event of an emergency.
- 6. Will you be camping?**
 - a. Camping is free and available for anyone who is interested. Please note during registration.
 - b. Room blocks have been reserved for Courage riders Saturday in Leavenworth at Icicle Village Resort. A list of other accommodations and additional information is available at ridewithcourage.org. Riders are responsible for booking their own accommodations.
- 7. Fundraising Minimums**
 - a. All fundraising minimums must be met by packet pick up. If you have not met your fundraising minimum, you will be required to pay for the remainder of your minimum or you will not be able to ride.
